BRINGING PAPER TO LIFE

Inspired by *kirigami*, the Japanese art of paper cutting & folding, Pagami are simple paper crafts you can make at home. Make your own Pagami **Labrador Retriever** with these five easy steps:

 Print on card stock

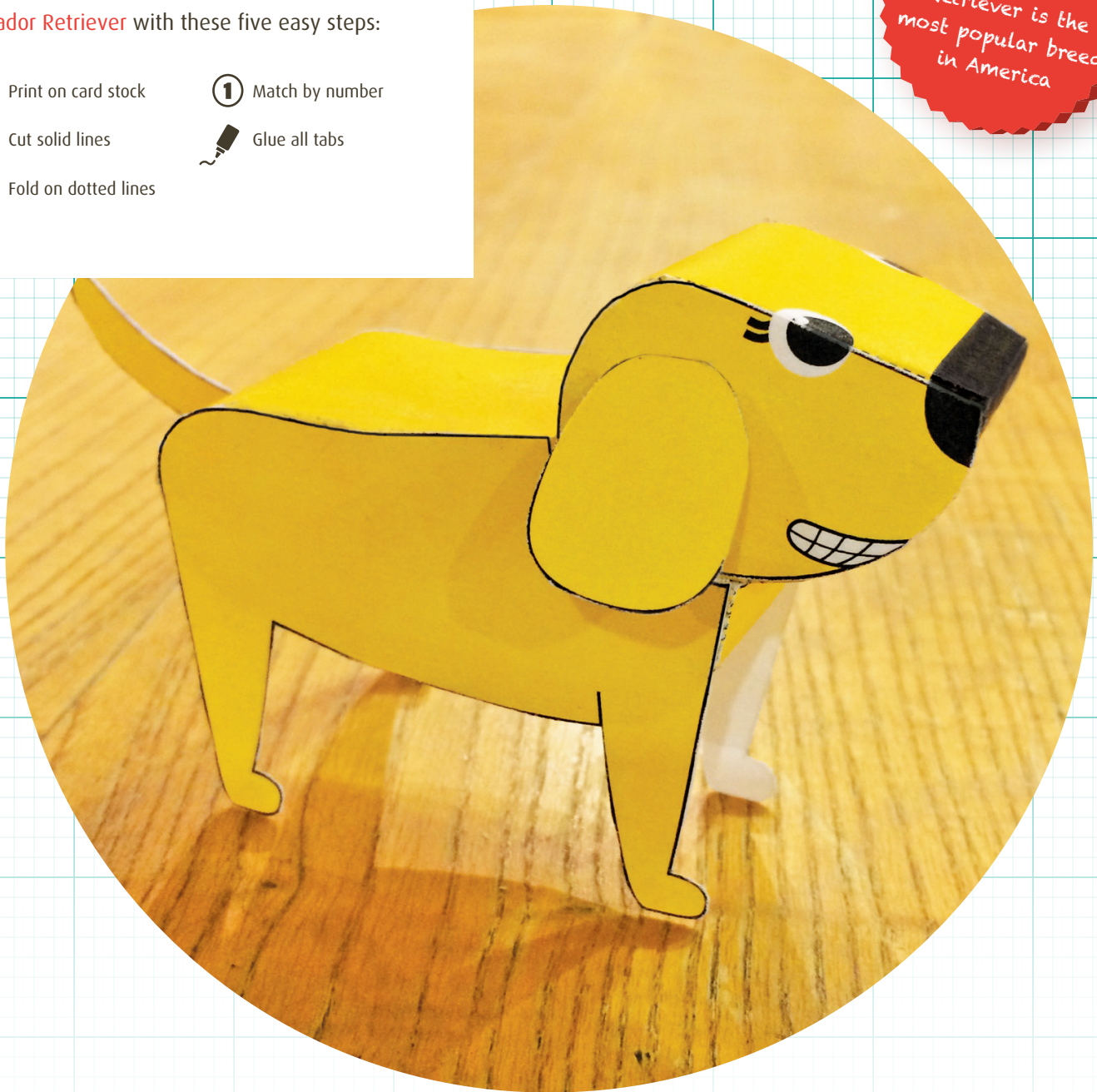
 Match by number

 Cut solid lines

 Glue all tabs

 Fold on dotted lines

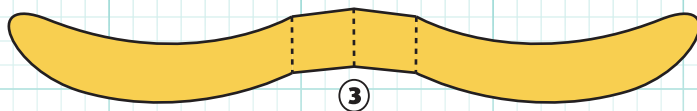
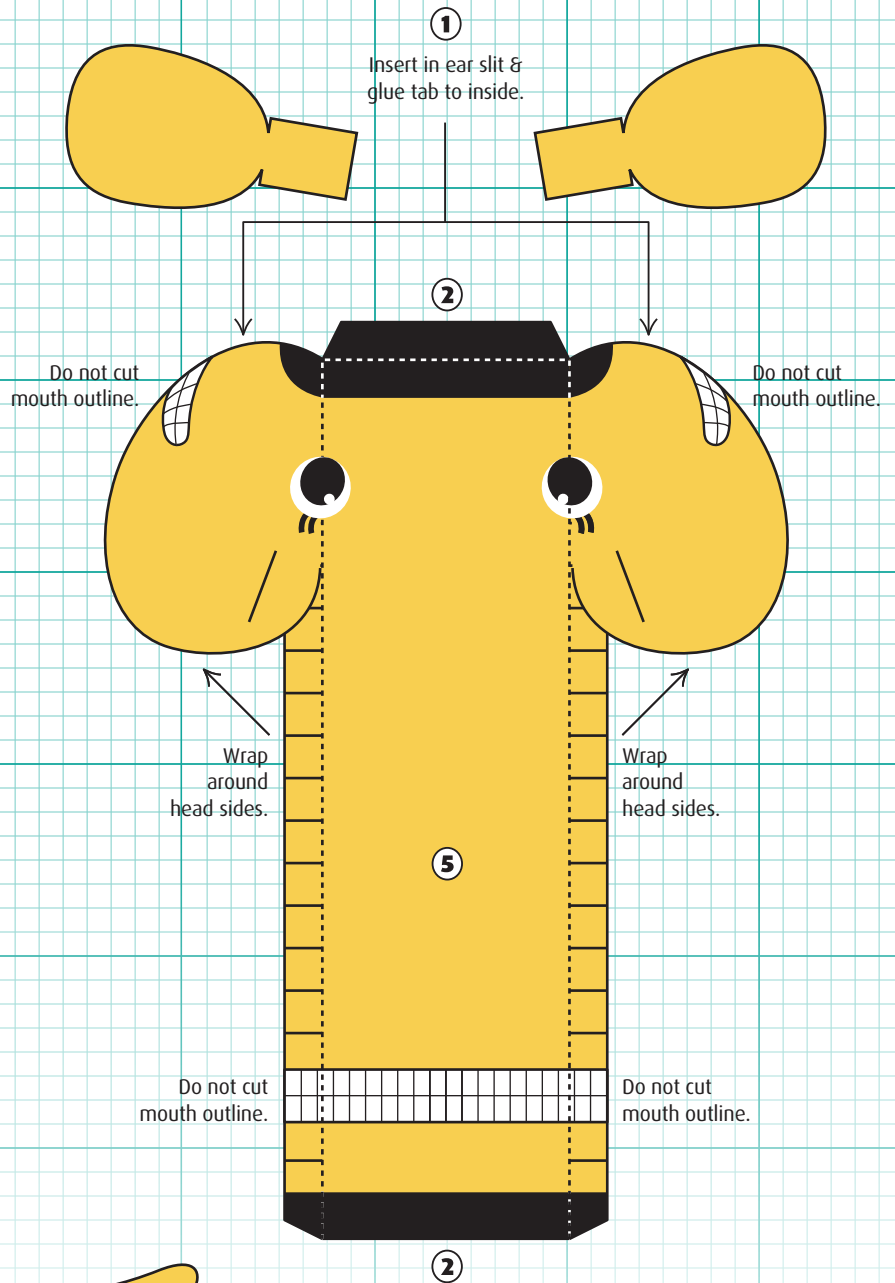
**FUN FACT!**

## Materials & Technique

For best results:

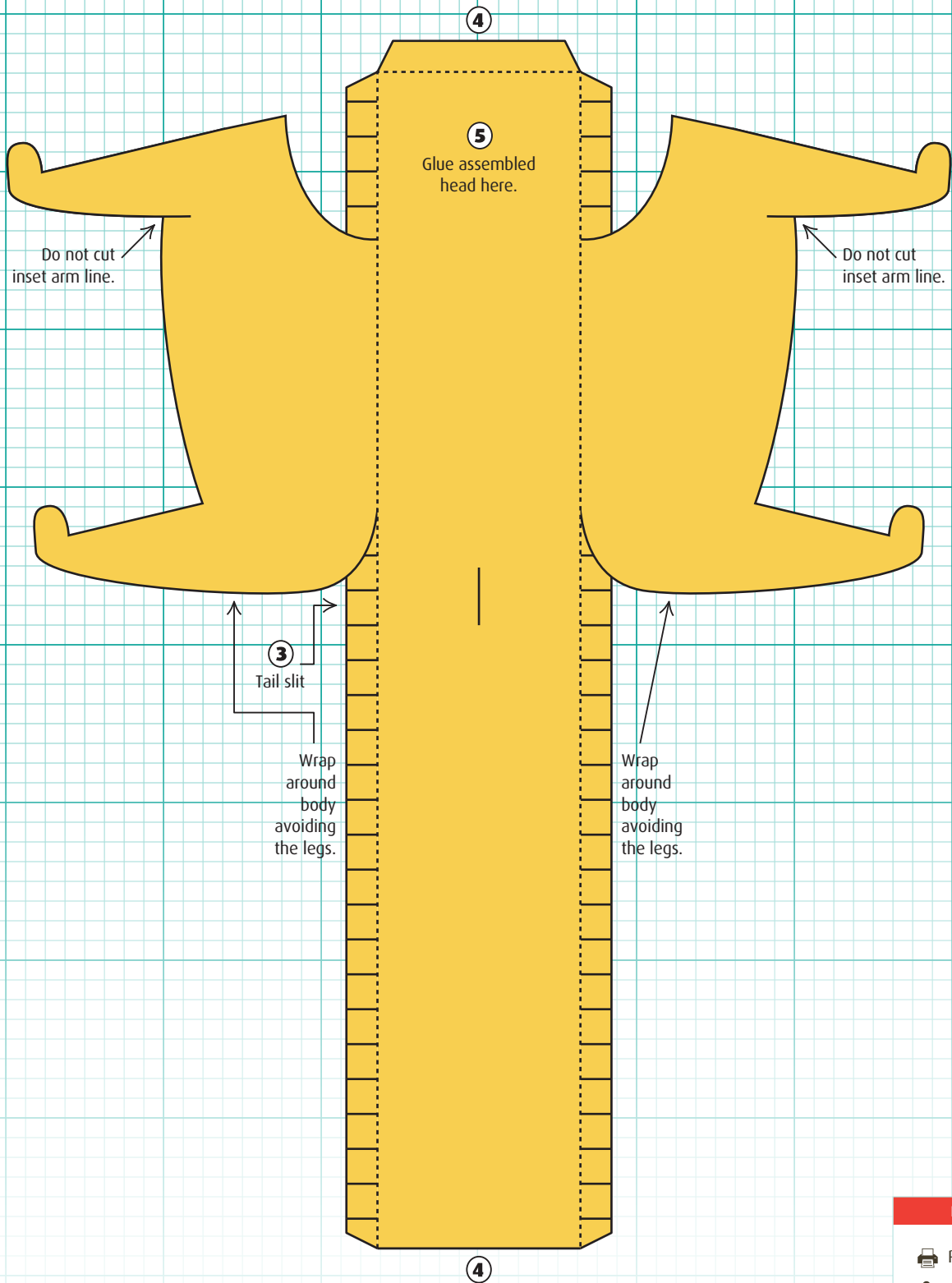
- Cut paper with a sharp **scalpel** or small crafting scissors. Scalpels are more precise.
- Cut on a **cutting mat** using even pressure and smooth cut strokes.
- Use a **bone folder** to score fold lines with light pressure before folding to ensure a crisp edge.
- Print on **non-glossy card stock** and handle paper lightly to ensure ink does not rub off.
- Use a **small paint brush** to apply a thin coat of **liquid white glue** to each tab.
- Cut away from yourself to prevent injury.
- Use a **metal ruler** to cut straight lines. A ruler with a foam or cork bottom is recommended as it will prevent slipping.
- If you make a mistake, simply reprint and try again.
- To make a smaller or larger Pagami, try using your printer's scaling options or take your Pagami PDF file to a copy shop for assistance.

Fold & glue back-to-back to form tail. Insert in tail slit on body & glue tab to inside.
